Guidelines For Counselors & Workers

1. Be responsible to know where each of your campers are at all times.
2. Make sure your group is at all scheduled events on time.
3. Be ready to meet your kids at alter calls.
4. No camper is to be left alone in a cabin at anytime.
5. Encourage each camper to participate or attend each planned function.
6. Be responsible to see that cabins are kept clean daily.
7. Any and all cell phones, pagers, radios, firecrackers, tobacco products, or any other item not allowed, are to be confiscated and turned in to the camp directors until camp is over. (Please put campers name on item.)
8. Encourage campers to be properly dressed for each activity.
9. Enforce all camp rules without being a respecter of persons.
10. All campers are required in all chapel services.
11. All campers must abide curfew. Lead by example in this! ! !
12. Boys and girls are not allowed at each others cabins or rest rooms.
13. If a camper insists that he/she must remain in the cabin due to illness, see that they go directly to the camp nurse.
14. Know your campers by first name as soon as possible.
15. Encourage your campers to take a shower every day.
16. A counselor is like a shepherd, campers are like sheep. Please be the shepherd that will bring forth good sheep. Your example will be a lasting one on the campers.
17. Be on guard to see that your campers are eating and drinking liquids each day.
18. Before retiring for the evening, encourage your campers to use the rest room. This will save accidents in bed and traveling back and forth in the night.
